To understand the unique economic and business environment in central China 3. Eligibility & Quota	<p>TWO international students registered in National Dong Hwa University (NDHU) during the program date.</p> <p>* If there are more than 2 students applying for this program, Office of International Affairs (OIA) will select 2 students by drawing lots online.</p>
Fees	<p>Participants are responsible for fees related to the program.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. RMB 7,800, including Housing, Teaching Materials, and Extra Curriculum Activities, paid upon arrival in Wuhan University 2. Transportation fees, such as airplane tickets (Taiwan to Wuhan, Wuhan to Lanzhou, Dunhuang to Taiwan) 3. Visa fee 4. Travel expenses 5. Insurance fee
Note	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Participants are responsible for booking their own airplane tickets, applying for visa, and buying insurance which covers travel and stay in China. 2. Participants must book the same flights that arrives in Wuhan on June 19, arrives in Lanzhou on July 9, and leaves Dunhuang on July 16. The pick-up service at Tianhe Airport of Wuhan will begin from 8:00 AM till 5:00 PM on June 19. 3. Participants must leave for the host university on the designated date and come back to Taiwan on schedule; they must not leave the camp

Participants are suggested preparing a performance (e.g. dance or sing) and an introduction Powerpoint (about NDHU, your department, club, etc.) together, in order to get prepared for some occasion in advance.</p> <p>5.
