# National Dong Hwa University Summer Intensive Chinese Program

## (Basic Level 1~4 & Intermediate Level 1~5)

# **Information Sheet**

## **Objectives:**

To provide an educational program for expatriate youth to improve their Chinese competency in areas of listening, speaking, reading and writing, to enhance their knowledge of Chinese and Taiwanese cultures, and to deepen their understanding of the establishment and development of Taiwan, the Republic of China.

## **Program Features:**

- 1. Chinese Language classes are taught by professional instructors.
- 2. Students are taught according to their levels (**See Appendix I**). The expected number for opening a course (LEVEL) is 6 and the maximum capacity of each class is 15 in order to achieve the efficiency of language teaching.
  - (When applicant number falls below than 6, CLC will notify applicants of the recalculated fees and re-inquire the applicants' willingness of application.) (See Appendix II for trial calculation.)
- There are multimedia devices in all classrooms, which are used regularly for teaching. Audio-visual classroom provides computers and other related equipment for learners.

#### **Prospective Learners Are:**

- 1. NDHU students.
- 2. Foreigners who are residents of Taiwan.

## Time of the Class & Classroom:

- 1. Program Schedule: 2014.07.07~ 2014.08.29
  - The Summer Intensive Chinese program will last for 8 weeks and provide 120 hours of Chinese instruction in total.
  - Time of Chinese class: Monday to Friday (AM 09:00~12:00)
- 2. Before the class starts, CLC will inform the applicants the classroom number on the bulletin of the Center.

#### **Registration Period: 2014.06.06 ~ 2014.06.20**

## Fees & Payment:

- 1. The total fees for the program is **NT\$ 24,000** per person, which covers the tuition and handouts. The textbook is **NOT** included in the Fees.
- 2. After the registration deadline (20/6/2014), CLC will inform the applicants whether the class level they choose to study in is opened. At the same time, CLC will provide applicants with a Remittance Account to make payment.

#### *Notice that:*

- 1. Under the normal circumstance, there must be at least 6 requests/students to open an advanced course. If the number falls below than 6, CLC will still open the course, welcome students to study, and recalculate the course fee for each student.
- 2. Tuition will not be refunded if students fail to attend class for personal reasons.
- 3. Paid tuition will be totally refunded if classes are canceled in lack of applicants.

#### **Certification:**

Every student who takes the Summer Intensive Chinese Program will receive a certificate which marks the total Chinese learning hours. (However, students who are absent for more than one third of the total program hours will not be issued the certificate.)
