

Accommodation

The Organizing Committee will arrange accommodation for all participants and advisors. Visa

International visitors to Republic of Singapore must carry a valid passport. Citizens of certain countries do require a Visa to come to Singapore. Each participant is responsible for applying for and obtaining a visa at the nearest Embassy or Consulate of the Republic of Singapore.
