MODULE 2: LANGUAGE (20 hours)

Spanish language. The course will provide the basics of the Spanish language: grammar, vocabulary and communication skills. At the end of the course you'll be able to:

- Introduce vourself and others and ask and answer questions about personal details.
- Interact in a simple wav provided the other person talks slowly and clearly.
- Read and overall understand very simple texts.
- Write a short, simple post card and fill in forms with personal details.
