at Seinan Gakuin University, Fukuoka, Japan

Seinan Gakuin University offers Summer Intensive Japanese language and culture Program in July 2019. Details are as follows.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

You are involved in a variety of activities both in and out of the classroom. Some class assignments require you to interact with people in the community.

The program is designed to give students abundant opportunities to use Japanese in and out of the classroom.

- ◆ Intensive Japanese language instruction at four different levels of classes I IV with about 10-15 students
- ◆ Language laboratory work and project work on and off campus
- Field trips to shrines, temples and other local attractions
- ◆ A field trip in/near Kyushu area to visit local sights of historical interest

1. Term: **July 1 (Mon.) – August 1 (Thu.), 2019**

2. Place: Seinan Gakuin University

3. Housing: Seinan Gakuin University International House (I-House)

Shared kitchens available at the International House

Room Facilities: Free Wi-Fi, Air conditioner, bed, desk, chair, refrigerator, toilet, lights, sink with hot and cold water.

- * Housing will be available from June 29 (Sat.) to noon, August 2 (Fri).
- * All the participants are expected to stay at the I-House.
- * Due to the balance of number of residents in the dormitory, participants might be placed in the off-campus dormitory
- * (twin bedded room).

4. Classes*: I, II, III, IV

Each course is taught by one teacher:

90 min. × 2 classes × 15 days and exams

* Project work (field work, interviews with Japanese students, etc) are scheduled outside regular class periods. For reference, see the last summer's class schedule.

- * Students should be able to use Te-Form in :

- * Class name and the contents are subject to change without notice due to students' Japanese language proficiency levels.
- 5. Capacity of the program: Maximum 40 students (4 classes)
- 6. Fees:
- 1) Application Fee: JPY 12,000 (non-refundable)

Payment information for Application fee will be informed after our receipt of your on-line application form.

- 2) Program Fee*: **150,000 JPY** for students from SGU's partner institutions **160,000 JPY** for students from other institutions
 - * Tuition fees, textbook fees, accommodation fee, rental futon fee, field trip to Dazaifu and a two-day field trip in/near Kyushu area are included.
 - * Air fare, meals, accident and medical insurance fee are not included.
 - * Field work fees (around 3,000 JPY) are not included.

Payment information for Program fee will be informed after your participation is admitted.

7. Refund Policy

Cancellation is accepted only by e-mail. (inbound@seinan-gu.ac.jp) Be sure that these dates are in "Japan Time".

- 1. Cancellation from June 1 to June 17, 2019: 20% penalty fee will be charged from Program fee.
- 2. Cancellation from June 18 to June 30, 2019: 50% penalty fee will be charged from Program fee.

- 3. Cancellation from July 1, 2019: 100% penalty fee will be charged from Program fee.
- *Remittance fee for refund will be deducted from the Program fees.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- College students enrolled in a course of study at the time of application.
- Applicants must have studied Japanese language that are equivalent to one semester at the time of application
- students should be able to use Te-Form in :
 - a) making requests (Please do ~)
 - b) giving and asking for permission (May I do~?)
 - c) forming a sentence that describes two events or activities.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Applicants must submit the following documents.

- 1. Completed application form(On-Line) Password: summer2019
- 2. Certificate to show that you are a student registered at your home institution
- Student ID is also acceptable if it is within the valid period.
- 3. ID photo (4cmx3cm)
- 4. Copy of passport
 - *Documents No. 2 4 are to be submitted after processing online application by digital data to inbound@seinan-gu.ac.jp.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

March 31, 2019

Once the number of applications reaches 40, further applications will be placed in the waiting list.

PLACEMENT TEST

Students are all given a placement test at the first of day of the program. They are placed in one of four levels of classes based on its results.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

You are required to obtain a travel insurance which covers all your medical expenses and personal liability during one month stay in Japan.
