3. Classes

OSession 1

This 2-week program is an introductory Japanese course for the students who have never learned Japanese before, or have very basic knowledge of Japanese like greetings, hiragana, and katakana. We offer this program as a pre-sessional course for entering Session 2 (4-week program: Summer Intensive Japanese Language and Culture Program)

OSession 2

This 4-week Intensive Japanese language and culture program is offered at four levels. Highly trained and skilled teachers provide a variety of activities both in and outside of the classes with the participants. Through these activities, participants are expected to learn Japanese language, including grammar, vocabularies, and expressions more effectively and intensively. Please note that absolute beginners have to start with Session 1.

- Four levels I-IV of classes with about 20 or fewer students
- Four-week intensive language instructions, exams, workshops, language lab activities, and on- and off-campus field work.
- Field trips to local shrines, temples and other local attractions.
- A two-day field trip in/near Kyushu area to visit local sights of historical interest
- * Project work (field work, interviews with Japanese students, etc) are scheduled outside regular class periods.
- * Placement Test: Students are all given a placement test before and after you enroll in this program. They are placed in one of four levels of classes based on its results.

7. Entry Requirements

Each of the programs has different entry requirements. To apply for one of the following programs, you must meet the requirements.

OSession 1 (2-week Program: June 22nd - July 3rd)

- Applicants must have completed that are equivalent to 12 years of education in educational institutions outside of Japan.
- -Applicants who have never studied Japanese before
- * You are required to be able to write and read Hiragana and Katakana before attending the program once you are admitted to the program.

OSession 2 (4-week Program: July 8th - August 5th)

- Applicants must have completed that are equivalent to 12 years of education in educational institutions outside of Japan.
- Applicants must have studied Japanese language that are equivalent to one semester at the time of application
- Applicants must be able to express following expressions using "Te-Form":
- a) making requests (Please do ~)
- b) giving and asking for permission (May I do~?)
- c) forming a sentence that describes two events or activities.

[Please Note] If you have already studied Japanese, <u>Session 2 (4-week program)</u> is the only option for <u>you.</u> Those who have never studied Japanese language before can choose either Session 1 (2-week program) or combined Session 1+Session 2 program depending on the period you wish to attend and your budget.

8. Required Documents

Applicants must submit the following documents.

- 1) Completed application form (On-Line) Password: summer2020
- 2) ID photo (4cmx3cm both color and black and white are acceptable.) (JPEG/PDF)
- 3) Copy of passport (PDF)
- 4) Certificate to show that you are a student enrolled at your home institution (PDF) (college/university student only)
- * Documents No. 2 4 are to be submitted after processing online application in pdf/jpg to: inbound@seinan-gu.ac.jp.

9. Application Deadline

March 31st, 2020

Once the number of applications reaches 60, further applications will be placed in the waiting list.

10. Placement Test (Session 2 only)

Students will be divided into four levels based on their Japanese proficiency. For your reference, there are two types of tests you need to take. The first one is an on-line Japanese test you need to take before coming to Fukuoka, and the other one is a test you need to take after you arrive at Seinan Gakuin University. Information about the on-line Japanese test will be announced in June.

11. Travel Insurance

You are required to obtain a travel insurance which covers all your medical expenses and personal liability during your stay in Japan.
