Teaching methods:

Students watch 13 online tutorials on Ewant, discuss and submit assignments on that platform, discuss related issues with the instructor via Facebook. Instructor will confirm student attendance and reply questions via these two websites. Mid-term and final exam will be conducted online. Final exam will be in written and students are required to submit to instructor (plagiarism will be considered fail); 5 distance learning tutorials will be expected on the Fridays 8pm in July 2020 via Cisco System, 18 tutorials in total.

During this course, other than watching videos and responding to instructor's questions, students will be required to read the reference book "Mind Learning: Wang Yang-ming Takes You to Bandit". Students will be required to submit a 1,000-word review report on Ewant platform. Final exam will be in written and students are required to submit comprehensive study file for this course.
