

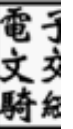

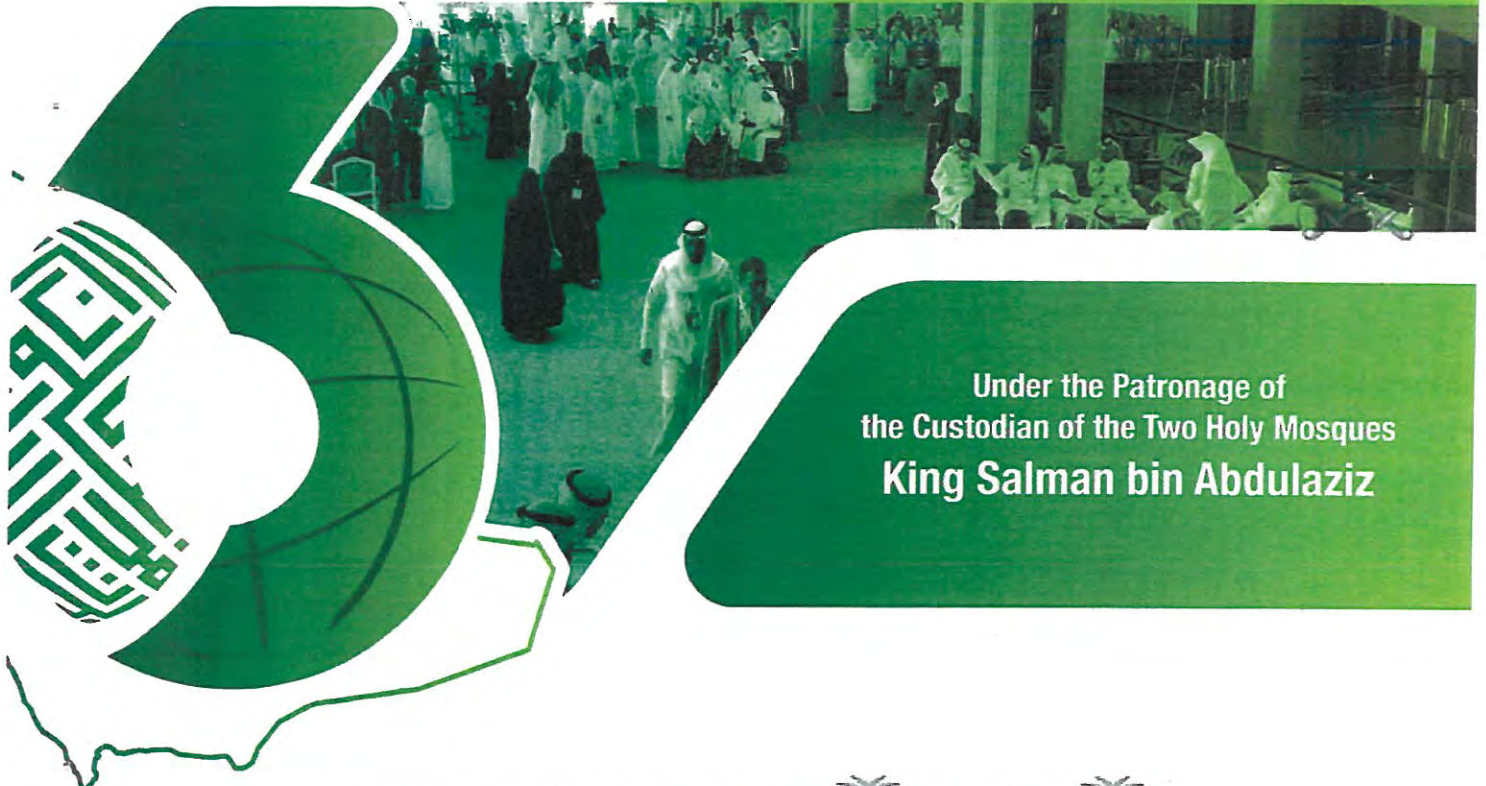

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An Introduction to Disability and Rehabilitation

Following the fundamental law, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia government has paid significant and increasing attention to individuals with disabilities and undertaken to support the various bodies that offer services for the disabled, promote their welfare, provide ultimate support to them, and provide them with all the necessary facilities that enable them to become active members of the society.



- The percentage of individuals with disabilities in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is estimated at 7-10% out of the 27,136,977 adult population according to the latest statistics issued by the General Authority for Statistics. The leading institutions undertaking the mission of safeguarding the rights of individuals with disabilities include:
 - i. (i) Authority of Persons with Disabilities,
 - ii. (ii) Ministry of Human Resources and Social Development,
 - iii. (iii) Ministry of Health,
 - iv. (iv) Ministry of Education,
 - v. (v) Ministry of Transport,
 - vi. (vi) Ministry of Municipal and Rural Affairs,
 - vii. (vii) Human Rights Commission.
 - viii. King Salman Center for Disability Research is the only scientific research center specialized in disability research. Since its foundation 30 years ago, it has implemented several distinguished national initiatives, including
 - ix. (i) early newborn screening,
 - x. (ii) organization of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia welfare system for persons with a disability,
 - xi. (iii) preparation of the universal accessibility guides,
 - xii. (iv) the National Health and Stress Survey, alongside several other national projects and programs.
- The Center, in cooperation with its partners, organized five (5) distinguished international conferences, which came out with multiple recommendations that led to several royal decrees and have integrated into public policies.





Event Title and Description

The 6th International Conference on Disability and Rehabilitation
An international conference organized periodically by King Salman Center for Disability Research, with a group of notable experts and scientists worldwide. The conference is characterized by a large number of participants of academics, specialists, experts, scientists, and individuals with disabilities.



The conference is peer-reviewed, and the information it issues is archived. The conference is held every two years in partnership with the relevant authorities so that it may be a platform for launching distinguished national initiatives, localizing technologies, and support services for people with disabilities, and finding solutions to overcome disability “in a scholarly and distinguished manner,” and through scientific research.

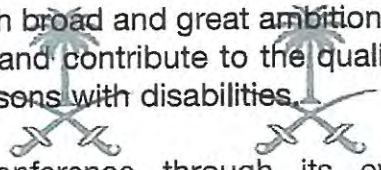

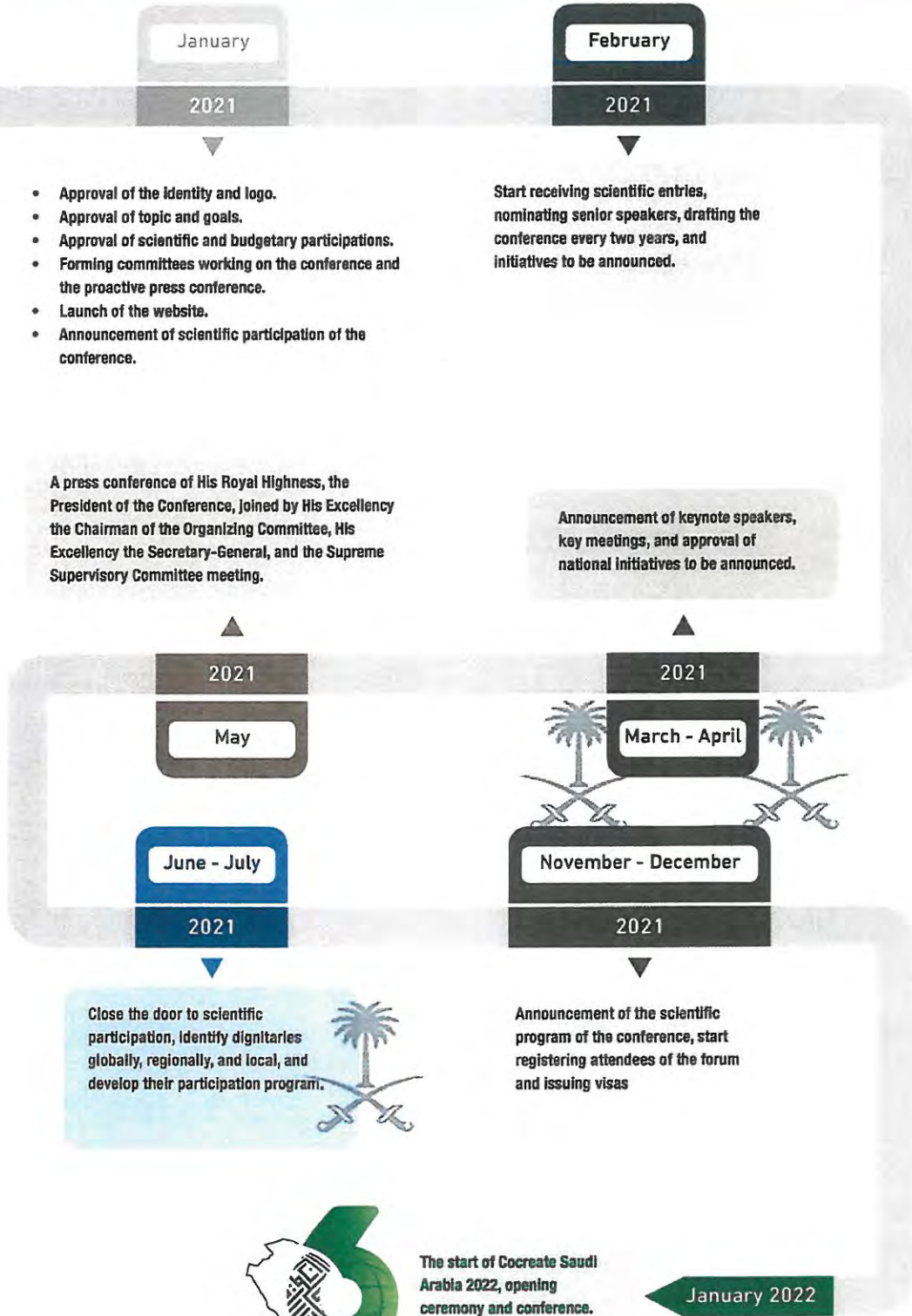

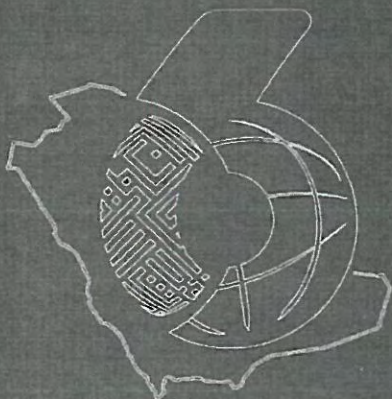
