The files should be prepared in Word format and submitted by email to ices2021@gms.ndhu.edu.tw.

- 1. Abstract
 - (1) The abstract should be around 250 words and include the title and up to 5 keywords.
 - (2) The abstract should follow either MLA or APA style.
 - (3) The abstract should be double-spaced and typeset in 12-point Times New Roman.
 - (4) Use A4 paper, and leave one-inch margins at the top and bottom and on both sides of the text.

2. Full Paper

- (1) The paper should be 8,000 words maximum in length, including discursive notes and bibliographical information.
- (2) Submit the paper along with a 250-word abstract and up to 5 keywords.
- (3) The paper should follow either MLA or APA style.
- (4) The paper should be double-spaced and typeset in 12-point Times New Roman.
- (5) Use A4 paper, and leave one-inch margins at the top and bottom and on both sides of the text.
