

Three-Stage Procedures of the University Presidential Search

First Stage

Article 15 of the National Dong Hwa University Operational Regulations for the Ninth-Term Presidential Search Committee:

The Presidential Search Committee shall review the qualifications of all nominated and self-nominated presidential candidates in accordance with the conditions stated in Article 6. A presidential candidate nominee passes the qualification review upon the consent of two-thirds or more of the quorum composed by two-thirds or more of the Committee members present at a review meeting.

Second Stage

Date: September 27, 2023

The Vote to Exercise the Right of Consent

Participants: All full-time faculty members (within and outside the staffing complement) and research personnel

(2) October 18, 2023. Wednesday, 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

2. Graduate Institute of Marine Biology, College of Environmental Studies and Oceanography:

October 17, 2023. Tuesday, 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Voters are to receive three ballots. An eligible candidate who obtains consent from two-fifths or more of all votes passes the threshold and may enter the Third Stage of the Presidential Search. (There must be two or more eligible candidates passing the threshold of consent.)

Third Stage

The Presidential Search Committee shall convene a meeting upon two or more eligible presidential candidates passing the threshold of consent. A resolution to select the University President requires the consent of more than a half of the quorum composed by two-thirds or more of the Committee members present at the meeting.
