The workload for the "International Business Seminar" corresponds to 3 ECTS. The participants will receive a certificate of participation.

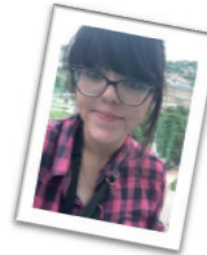
Program fee

Hiking in the Black Forest

The Black Forest can be hiked through along thousands of kilometers of hiking trails. Enjoy the beautiful landscape and the original Black Forest Cake.

Heidelberg

Visit the beautiful Heidelberg Castle! But there is much more, a charming old town, a student dungeon, an enchanting setting to lean back and feel your spirit, you can lose your heart in Heidelberg!

Berlin

Visit Germany's capital with its iconic attractions like the Brandenburg Gate, Berlin is famous for its cultural heritage and its vibrant night life. Join a four-day field trip with visits at Deutsche Bahn, the logistics center of Germany's biggest drugstore chain, the German parliament, the Wall, and the Holocaust memorial.

Strasbourg

Karlsruhe is only five kilometers from the border and Strasbourg with the European Parliament is just an hour away. Enjoy tarte flambée and the typical French Savoir Vivre.

If you wish to explore a little more of Europe after the program, Karlsruhe is the ideal starting point. From Karlsruhe/Baden-Baden Airport, you can fly to southern Europe at low cost, but you can also quickly reach Switzerland and Italy by train. The train to Paris takes less than three hours.
